All Camper Code of Conduct

-Medications are NOT to be kept by the campers and/or counselors. ANY AND ALL medications (prescription and over-the-counter must be turned in to senior camp staff upon arrival.

-No public/private displays of affection permitted between campers at any time.

LADIES:

-Dress clothes for chapel: modest loose fitting skirts/dresses covering the knee, and tops or blouses. -Activity clothes: loose fitting shorts covering the knee and dark t-shirt with no inappropriate advertising.

-Modest sleepwear covering the knee.

-Swimwear: One piece swimsuit with cover up robe or dark loose fitting shorts covering the knee with a dark t-shirt.

GENTLEMEN:

-Dress clothes for chapel services: Collared shirt and pants.

-Activity clothes: loose fitting pants or shorts covering the knee and t-shirt.

-Swimwear: swim trunks covering the knee and t-shirt.

What to Bring to Camp
